

## MO RANCH TRIP INFO March 6-8, 2010

Monday, March 1 Parent form due

Friday, March 5 LUGGAGE CHECK-IN (See specific times on the back of this paper)

Drop off BOTH Carry-On & Suitcase to Ensemble Rm- No exceptions.

Remain with luggage while it is checked (You may bring small baggie with make-up/toothpaste on Sat. morning to put in carry-on

Friday, March 5- Report to Choir Room (See schedule on the back)

Monday, March 8 6-6:30Pm- Return-Arrival to LHS

**GENERAL INFO:** Mo Ranch is a Camp/Conference Center located a few miles out of Hunt, Texas, which is owned and operated by the Presbyterian Church. It is very large and its property is on either side of the Guadalupe River. We will have accommodations with four students in a room- two queen-sized beds and a bathroom. All linens will be furnished. The Booster Club provides snacks, water, & soft drinks during the day. All meals are provided on premise and are served cafeteria style. The students will have access to all kind of sports and (weather permitting) students may canoe. Many hiking trails and nature trails are available. We will be taking many table games and puzzles for indoors. The schedule will consist of intense rehearsals and relaxing recreation! Of course, ALL SCHOOL UNIFORM TRAINING RULES apply while we are on the trip. ### THINGS TO BRING

1 SMALL Suitcase- pack light/1 Carry- on

Alarm clock

Jacket

Umbrella (it will rain)

Flashlight (everyone needs one)

Jeans, t-shirts (school dress code) No pajama pants.

No swimsuits. No shorts unless knee length.

Tennis shoes, hiking appropriate Extra pair is helpful! (no flip flops, sandals, or house shoes outside of rooms)

Music/Folder/Pencil

No cell phones, radios, tape/cd players, jam boxes, TV's, water guns, slingshots, skateboards, or roller blades are allowed.

Tennis rackets, basketball or other sports equipment if you want to play.

Board game and/or cards

**Medications you normally take (Allergy stuff is really important). Pack in Carry-On**

**(Take motion sickness medicine BEFORE leaving home.)**

Epi-pens & inhalers should be with you at all times.

Sunscreen & Bug repellent

Hats for outside (No hats indoors or on bus)

HOMEWORK for the bus

### THINGS TO REMEMBER

Mo Ranch is a church camp with specific rules & guidelines. WE ARE GUESTS.

Your exemplary behavior is REQUIRED. (Manners- language)

ALL UNIFORM TRAINING RULES APPLY.

There are no phones or TV's in rooms. (You may use pay phone to call home)

No boys in girls' rooms. No girls in boys' rooms- not even on the floor or hallways.

You may visit in common areas (King Dining Hall, Dishman, outdoor recreation areas)

Curfew is in your room not your neighbor's.

You do not leave your room after curfew or before chaperones remove tape.

Breakfast is a 7:30am (not optional) Come dressed!

At all meals- do not leave Dining Hall until dismissed by Ms. E or Ms. B

No hats on busses or indoors.

No screaming at any time.

Do not throw trash off bridges or on property.

No jumping off bridges.

No slide. No swimming.

Rooms are to be kept "picked-up" (Trash in cans, clothes in suitcases, drawers or hanging)

Vandalism of any degree will not be tolerated

Definition of "Quiet Time"- no talking, sleep or read-quiet activities
